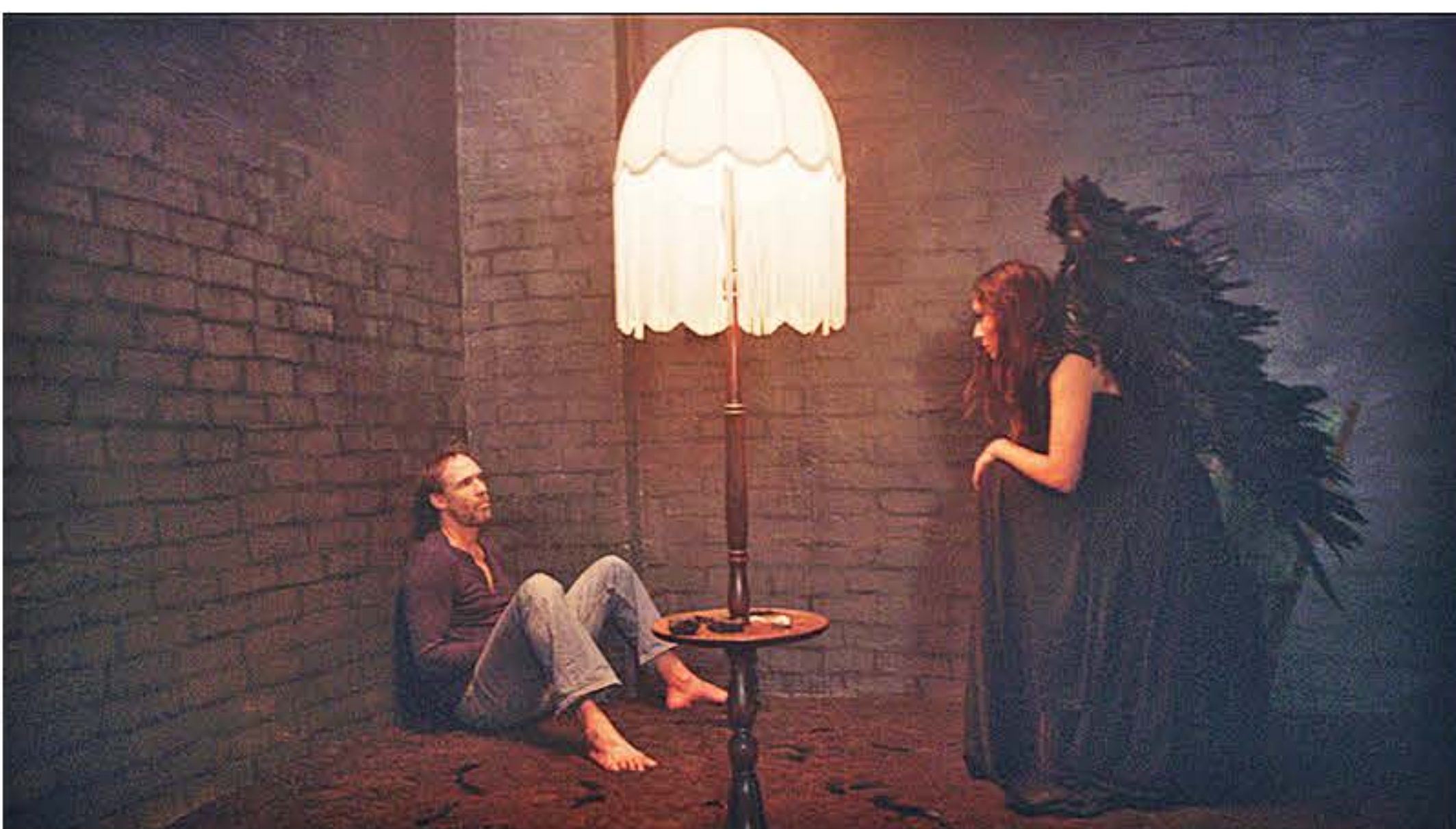


“420”
